### ENTRY RULES FOR RABBITS

1. All Open Show Rabbit entries are required to be entered on the Animals Only Form (found in the fair book). 4-H members must fill out the Jr. Fair Animal Entry Form (also found in the fair book). All entry forms must be either postmarked or entered at the Secretary's Office by 3:00 p.m. Wednesday, August 8, 2007.

2. To exhibit you must purchase either a \$20.00 Exhibitor Ticket or a Membership Ticket. 4-H members are exempt from purchasing an Exhibitor ticket when entering 4-H projects in the Open Show, but must pay entry fees. 4-H members showing non 4-H animals in the Open Show must purchase an Exhibitor ticket.

3. Entry Fees: Single Rabbit or Cavy \$ .75.  
Rabbit Doe & Litter \$1.50

4. Eligibility to Exhibit:

- Competition open to all
- Animals must be owned by the Exhibitor.

### — SHOW RULES —

1. This is an official American Rabbit Breeders Association Sanctioned Show, and will be governed by the latest show rules of the A.R.B.A. Inc. Filing an entry blank indicates acceptance of A.R.B.A. Rules. Limit of 20 Single Rabbits, 10 cavies, and 1 Rabbit Doe and litter per Exhibitor. The Director has the right to refuse any entry.

2. **ALL RABBITS MUST BE PERMANENTLY TATTOOED.** Use of felt markers and ballpoint pens are **NOT** considered permanent ear markers.

3. The Geauga County Fair Board cannot assume responsibility for loss or damage to stock; however, reasonable precautions will be taken for protection.

4. **All rabbit and cavy entries must be health checked by the staff and be in their appropriate cages between noon and 9:00 p.m. on Wednesday night before the fair.**

5. **Any electric cord used on the fairgrounds has to be 3 wire 14 gauge UL approved.**

6. No rabbits or cavies unless being exhibited are allowed onto the fairgrounds at any time. The sale of any rabbits or cavies not exhibited in the fair is prohibited.

7. **Rabbits will be released at 6:00 p.m. at completion of horse shows on Monday night, the last day of the fair, in accordance to security measures we have installed.**

8. **All rabbits and cavies must be removed from the rabbit building by 9:30 p.m. on Monday evening of the fair.** Any exhibit not removed by 9:30 p.m. on Monday evening will be disposed of at the discretion of the Superintendent.

9. Any exhibitor who removes their rabbit before release time on Monday, the last day of the fair, without permission from the Senior Fair Director will automatically forfeit all premiums.

10. All Exhibitors must furnish own feed. Exhibitors must also furnish containers for feed and water for their animals.

11. **Exhibitors will be held responsible for the care of their animals and cleaning cage trays (including Monday night).** Shavings will be provided. Absolutely **NO** straw or hay in cages at any time.

12. Remark cards must be completed during checking on Wednesday night.
