| Jackpot Classes: | \$10.00 Entry Fee - 100% Payback of Entry Fees Plus \$50.00 Added. Purse Split: 40% - 25% - 20% - 10% - 5% for First Five Places | 2. Horses 58" and over. Registered Horse Breed under 58" must Provide Papers. |
| Contest Classes: | \$5.00 Entry Fee - Electric Timer Fee \$2.00. 80% Payback of Entry Fee. Purse Split: 45% - 25% - 10% for First Three Places. | 3. Rider's age determined as of January 1. |
| Awards: | Trophy and 5 Ribbons per Class. High Point Award and Reserve Ribbon Awarded for Horse and Rider Accumulating Most Points. High Point Awards will be separated as Follows: WALK/TROT, WESTERN, and CONTESTING. | 4. Five horses constitute a class. |
