RULES

Only one rooster will be permitted in each cage. No other bird may accompany competing bird during the contest.

Rooster may be of any breed, any age. Cages will be covered at 3:30 p.m. at the ring and prior to contest time, 4:00 p.m. Please bring papers to show that roosters are tested for Pullorum. Your Roosters can be tested 6 - 9 p.m. Wednesday, August 27 at the Poultry Barn.

Register at the contest by 3:30, Sunday, August 31, 2008.

A judge will be assigned to each coop to tally times the bird crows in one-half hour after coops are uncovered. You may leave top of cage covered during contest.

Awards will be made for bird crowing most times in half hour as follows: First **\$15.00**; Second **\$10.00**; Third **\$5.00**, and **\$1.00** for each bird that is entered. An extra **\$5.00** for the first place bird if he crows more than 96 times - Great Geauga County Fair Record. 2007 Winner was Sunny, who crowed 48 times and is owned by Laura Maddox.

Limit: 2 birds per owner. Owner to furnish cages and covers. Suggest that cage be twice as tall as rooster.
